teenage engineering's longtime friends and collaborators mikael ericsson and micke reuter have been creating experimental visuals and abnormal music that explore the limits of creation itself. they showcase different teenage engineering products like the POM-400 and OP-1 field through their art and very important scientific research. now out in the field again working on something special, they present a limited edition visual anthology that documents the sinus transmission completed motion picture project and includes the original soundtrack.

the 20-page gatefold book (260 × 260 × 15 mm) is teenage engineering records' third release. it contains drawings, photographs, and texts from the film sinus transmission completed, and includes two 10" vinyl records housed in silver sleeves. printed on shiny, heavy stock (300gr and 157gr c2s), the paper features gold, silver, and chrome finishes. all photographs, drawings, texts, trailer, and soundtrack are created by the swedish artist duo mikael ericsson and micke reuter. the design and production of the book are made by teenage engineering.
