mr. update has sent out a fresh EP-series update. after the success of the EP-133 K.O. II champions update, teenage engineering is back with even more, rolling out three new updates across the K.O. II, riddim, and medieval. these updates bring out some handy studio features, including reverse playback, expanded keys mode with new scales and arpeggiator options, equal-length autochop, and usb audio support. it's everything that made the originals great, now pushed even further.

## EP-133 & EP-40

the EP-133 K.O. II and EP-40 riddim receive a significant update, introducing new features that enhance both workflow and creative flexibility. both devices now function as class-compliant usb audio devices, enabling direct sampling from computers or mobile devices, as well as seamless streaming of the main mix without the need for drivers. sample playback improvements include:

- reverse playback as a timestretch mode
- enhanced audio quality for heavily stretched material
- equal-length autochop
- adjustable recording sample rates
- and simplified sample cropping.

keys mode adds new scales, per-project key selection, and arpeggiation with note repeat. midi updates include song position pointer support, sustain pedal input, and expanded fx control via midi cc-further strengthening both the K.O and riddim as versatile sampling instruments.

## EP-1320

mr. update did not forget about the beloved EP-1320 medieval. from now on medieval also operates as a class-compliant usb audio device, allowing users to sample directly from a computer or smartphone and stream the main output without requiring drivers.
